7th Migrating Course on Epilepsy is an annual interactive course run over 6 days in new locations around Europe, recognizing a local need to the area where the course is based (2007 Serbia, 2008 Lithuania, 2009 Czech Republic, 2010 Poland, 2011 Rome, 2012 Porto). This year the course will take place in Cyprus.

The course is a mixture of introductory lectures and interactive tutorials, with faculty asked to attend for a minimum of three days to interact with students.

Prospective participants are invited to submit two case reports (maximum one page abstract each).

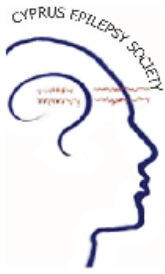

All abstracts must be supplied in English. The deadline for submission of abstracts is 1st June 2013. The prospective candidates will be notified by 1st July 2013.

Each applicant submits 2 cases. A bursary is given only to applicants under <45 years according to the results of the evaluation of application.

Bursary allowance includes: Seminar materials, Lodging, Meals, and Social Program

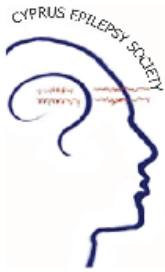
THE VENUE
