The language of teaching and writing of the dissertation thesis is Greek.

The application must include two undergraduate essays on archaeological topics, or in case of graduates of other related subjects two undergraduate essays on relevant topics. Additionally submit certificates of good knowledge of two foreign languages.

The candidates for the **PhD** programme should be graduates of a Master's programme in Archaeology or other relevant sciences (History of Art, Architecture, Anthropology, Ancient History and other sciences supportive for Archaeology, like Geology, Physics and Chemistry), from a recognized University. The candidates judged as qualified will be asked to an interview. They should also have successfully passed a written examination in two of the basic European languages (English, French, German, Italian and Spanish).

6. The names and addresses of University Professors. The candidates should request letters of recommendation to be sent directly to the Coordinator of Postgraduate Studies of the Department. **Letters must bear an original signature and be submitted in a stamped envelope.** The Department may request additional confidential information from the referees. For the Faculty of Engineering all recommendation letters should be written on a special form, which can be found on the website <http://www.ucy.ac.cy/goto/acafsw/en-US/PostgraduateOffice.aspx>.

Postgraduate Programme: Master's Degree

Master's Programmes offered in Greek: €5.125 per programme

Postgraduate Programme: PhD Degree

1. Holders of Master's degrees: Total fees €4.000
2. Non-holders of Master's degrees: Total fees €6.500 provided that they complete the requirements of their programme and acquire the PhD title within six years (12 semesters).

Each year of study, beyond the six years, with a maximum duration of 8 years (16 semesters) corresponds to tuition fees of €1.250 each year. (Maximum tuition fees are €9.000).
